Before you know it, we will be heading to the United Kingdom for the 21st World Scout Jamboree! The closer it gets, the more we need to finalize plans and commitments. We have deadline dates that must be met, and we want to bring them to your attention.

The following information must be returned **to the jamboree registrar** in the national office:

- Personal information form
- Copy of your passport or entry document

Please send the information form and a copy of your passport to the Jamboree Division, S203, Boy Scouts of America, 1325 West Walnut Hill Lane, P.O. Box 152079, Irving TX, 75015-2079, **no later than February 28, 2007**. You may send them electronically to worldjamboree@netbsa.org.

The following information must be provided to your jamboree Scoutmaster:

- Personal health and medical record form (two copies)
- Parental travel consent form
- Copy of your personal information form
- Copy of your passport or entry document

If you require a medical alert, it must be submitted before **February 15, 2007**, to the jamboree health and safety adviser, S230. Please use the medical form supplied online at the jamboree web site, www.scouting.org/jamboree/world. Please send a copy; **do not send the original form**. If you have any questions as to whether you require a medical waiver, please e-mail the health and safety adviser, bsteale@netbsa.org, before the February 15 deadline.

On the reverse side of this letter, you will find more information concerning your trip. If you have any questions or concerns, your primary source is your jamboree Scoutmaster, (name). Be sure to stay in touch!

2007 World Scout Jamboree Fact Kit

Passport

The United Kingdom does not require a visa for entry for citizens of United States of America, but a valid passport is required. It is necessary for the Jamboree Division and your Scoutmaster to have a copy of your passport. If you have not applied for your passport, do so immediately!

Parental Travel Consent Form

The United Kingdom requires a notarized statement allowing entry into their country without the accompaniment of your parent(s). **This is not an optional form.** You must complete and return the notarized form to your Scoutmaster and keep a notarized copy for your records at home.

Personal Information Form

The Scout Association has asked for assistance in collecting registration information from our participants and leaders. Please use the personal information form enclosed. If some questions seem a little odd, remember they are collecting information from Scouts all over the world for their registration database. This form should be returned to the jamboree registrar before February 28, 2007, and a copy provided to your Scoutmaster.

Airline Tickets

Your airline tickets will be mailed to you in June 2007. As soon as your departure city has been established, the information will be shared with your Scoutmaster. This should take place before the end of February. Transportation to and from the gateway airport is your responsibility.

Jamboree Souvenirs

The national Supply Group will release an online catalog of BSA World Scout Jamboree items in March. You will receive the identification number and password at that time. Some items will be restricted for sale just to jamboree participants, but some items will be sold to the BSA membership.

Personal Jamboree Items Supplied to Participants

As a part of your participation fee you will receive:

- 1 contingent neckerchief
- 1 day pack
- 1 large duffle bag
- 1 rain poncho
- 1 name tag
- 2 contingent emblems

The first contingent emblems will be mailed to you after you have paid \$1,650. You may proudly wear the emblem on your uniform to signify your participation in this event. Please wear this temporary emblem centered on the right pocket. When your registration fee is paid in full, your second emblem will be mailed to you. The United Kingdom will present the official 2007 World Scout Jamboree emblem to you upon arrival at the jamboree site. This emblem is worn above or on the right pocket. If you attended the 2005 National Scout Jamboree, please remove the emblem from your uniform.

Refund Policy

Written notice of cancellation must be sent to the national office in Irving, Texas, to the attention of the jamboree registrar, either by mail, fax, or e-mail at worldjamboree@netbsa.org prior to the jamboree. Requests made after the event will not be considered. Refunds are subject to the amounts of contractual agreements made on behalf of the applicant. Deposit fees paid by alternates not selected as active participants will be refunded in full. The following refund dates apply:

- After January 15, 2007 \$500 Nonrefundable
- After March 15, 2007 \$1,000 Nonrefundable
- After April 15, 2007 \$2,500 Nonrefundable
- After June 15, 2007 No refunds
